Greetings Conservationists,

As discussed at some of your area association meetings this summer, WI Land+Water is conducting state Land and Water Conservation Board (LWCB) elections this fall, as opposed to March (this is happening mainly due to the timelines of our LWCB elections not aligning well with the actual term they serve). Next month, you will see the 2024 Election Policy (once approved by the board) that will explain the steps, but I wanted to provide some info ahead of that so LCC members considering running for a LWCB seat can plan accordingly, likewise area coordinators.

- WI Land+Water's member counties will elect three LWCB reps to serve a two-year term that begins January 2025.
- Each area association is encouraged to nominate a candidate to the LWCB. The candidate's name and a one-page biography will be due to Kelli Myers (<u>kelli@wisconsinlandwater.org</u>) by noon on Monday, September 30, 2024. Area associations should consider meeting ahead of this to nominate a candidate (or modifying a summer tour to accommodate a brief business session to nominate a candidate).
- Candidates will be contacted the week of September 30 to schedule a Zoom meeting that will occur the week of October 7, where WI Land+Water staff will assist candidates in recording their [up to five minute] address to membership stating their qualifications for the LWCB. Candidates will be provided questions to answer in their address prior to the week of October 7.
- Information on voting (one vote per county) will be shared during the October 17-18, 2024 County Conservation Meeting in Stevens Point, and more broadly with our LCC and LCD listservs.
- Ballots and key information, including how and where to view the candidates' recordings, will be sent to each County Conservationist (or appropriate staff as previously determined) the week of October 21. An email will also be sent to the LCC and LCD listservs so all WI Land+Water members can view the recordings at their convenience. Voting will end at 5:00 pm on Friday, November 29, 2024.
- Winning LWCB candidates will be announced in December.
