

Types of Home Care:

Supportive Care: Household tasks that do not involve making physical contact.

Examples: grocery shopping, meal preparation, companionship, light cleaning, laundry

<u>Personal Care:</u> Tasks that involve a helper making physical contact, often hygiene related. Examples: bathing, dressing, grooming, toileting, changing bed linins, assistance with mobility

Skilled Care: Tasks completed by trained medical professionals.

Examples: medication management, wound care, IV therapy, blood draw, skilled therapy services. *See Healthcare Resources Handout for Skilled Care Options.*

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Things to Consider When Choosing an Agency to Provide Care for You or a Loved One

Agency:

- Is the agency insured? (All agencies on this list are insured)
- Do they have a good reputation in the community?
- What is their staff turnover rate?

Staff:

- Are care providers background checked? How extensive is that check?
- What sort of training is required for care providers?
- Will I be able to keep the same caregiver?
- Am I able to request a specific gendered care provider for personal care tasks?

Cost:

- What is the cost of their services?
- Do they have a required minimum number of service hours?
- How can these services be paid for?

Scheduling:

- Do you have specific hours of service or is staff also available overnight, on weekends or on holidays?
- How much advance notice is required for scheduling care?
- What is the availability of their staff?
- How often can they provide services?

Hiring an outside agency isn't the right solution for everyone who finds themselves in need of home care. Some other options to consider are:

- Paying a friend, family member, or other private party to provide the care that you need. (we suggest doing a background check and having a caregiver agreement on file if you select this option)
- Consult with your friend group, family, faith community or other social network to share their experiences with services, solutions, agencies, and providers in the area.
- Think about taking something else off your plate to free up time, energy, or funds to get the care that you need.
