3. **Call Medicare (1-800-633-4227) Open 24/7** – best to call outside of office hours for lower call volume. Medicare offers unbiased information by trained staff on all plans available.

4. **Call Medigap Helpline (1-855-677-2783) serves ages 60+**

Medigap helpline offers unbiased information by licensed insurance agents on all plans available.

You will leave a message and receive a call back; keep in mind there are limited staff available

5. **Call Disability Rights Wisconsin (DRW) Helpline (1-800-926-4862) serves ages 18-59**

DRW helpline offers unbiased information by trained staff on all plans available.

6. **Call individual Medicare Plans**

Each plan will only have information on the plans they offer. To compare pricing, you need to call more than one plan and have your current drug list ready.
