3. Call Medicare (1-800-633-4227) **Open 24/7** – best to call outside of office hours for lower call volume. Medicare offers unbiased information by trained staff on all plans available.

4. Call Medigap Helpline (1-855-677-2783) serves ages 60+

Medigap helpline offers unbiased information by licensed insurance agents on all plans available. You will leave a message and receive a call back; keep in mind there are limited staff available

5. Call Disability Rights Wisconsin (DRW) Helpline (1-800-926-4862) serves ages **18-59** DRW helpline offers unbiased information by trained staff on all plans available.

6. Call individual Medicare Plans

Each plan will only have information on the plans they offer. To compare pricing, you need to call more than one plan and have your current drug list ready.
