_____ shall procure from a reputable company authorized to do business in Wisconsin and keep in force general liability insurance for activities covered by this parade permit and shall furnish Eau Claire County with a certificate of such insurance with respect to which the County shall be named as additional insured.

Coverage: (minimum)

Bodily injury.....\$100,000 per person
\$250,000 aggregate

Property Damage.....\$250,000
(or a single limit policy of \$500,000)

This permit shall be valid when the following "Rules of the Road" are followed:

Unless the highway has been closed to other traffic:

- A) participants shall yield the right-of-way to motor vehicles on the highway
- B) pedestrians shall walk along the left side of the highway and when meeting a vehicle, if practicable, step to the extreme outer limit of the traveled portion of the highway
- C) bicyclists shall ride single file on all roadways which have center lines or lanes indicated by painting or other markings, and single file in all rural areas. On roadways not marked with center lines, riding two abreast is permitted
